### **EXTRA TIPS**

**Start specific:** Give AI enough context — business type, location, audience.

**Ask for questions:** Ask Al to ask you questions until it can give a great answer

**Always edit:** Make sure it still sounds like you.

**Ask again**: Don't be afraid to say "Make it shorter" or "Try a more friendly tone."
